FIFA Football Law Annual Review – third edition

In 2019, FIFA organised the first-ever FIFA Football Law Annual Review (FLAR). This was a major breakthrough after a lengthy period of restricted access to the information, data and decisions of the main FIFA judicial bodies and to Court of Arbitration for Sport proceedings.

Transparency and openness in relation to the operations, initiatives, decisions and challenges of football is of paramount importance to FIFA today. At the same time, the opinions, views and proposals of football stakeholders are all important and welcomed.

In 2020, the second edition of the FLAR was planned to take place in Buenos Aires with more than 350 registered participants. Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, it was delivered in online form, with more than 1,000 viewers attending the various presentations.

We are pleased to announce that we will be holding the third edition of the FLAR on 22 and 23 March 2021. Due to the current international restrictions in place, the event will take place virtually and be streamed on FIFA.com.

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, it was delivered in online form, with more than 1,000 viewers watching detailed presentations of FIFA's regulations and legal decisions and CAS football-related cases.

This 3rd edition of the FLAR is establishing a firm tradition of holding an annual global conference featuring the game's principal practitioners and football stakeholders worldwide to discuss recent developments and future challenges.

In addition to the 2020 review, **the 3**rd **edition of the FLAR** will focus on the most important decisions rendered by FIFA's judicial bodies and CAS, as well as the new regulations passed by FIFA.
